



SOUTHERN ROSALINA

(*Melaleuca ericifolia*)

DATA DETAILS

Southern Rosalina is a long-established native plant in Tasmania, but its essential oil is a rather recent and beautifully scented gift to the aromatic world.

To make our Southern Rosalina oil, Tasmanian *Melaleuca ericifolia* is harvested from wild-crafted populations grown on Flinders Island, part of the Tasmanian archipelago of islands. Southern Rosalina is hardy and adaptive, and grows around the coastal areas and hilly slopes of this pristine island in soils with varying levels of salinity. Only select populations and regrowth areas are harvested to ensure oil consistency and sustainability.

Being a member of the *Melaleuca* family, and similar to Tea Tree, Southern Rosalina carries a mild cineole aroma but, due to its linalool content, is matched with a refreshing lavender back note. Hence it is also commonly known as “Lavender Tea Tree”. The composition of this Tasmanian oil differs from the traditional Australian mainland Rosalina as it has a generally lower linalool content.



Due to its content (> 30%) 1,8-cineole, an important respiratory support molecule, Southern Rosalina is useful for respiratory relief and congestion and also aids as a mild antiseptic and anti-bacterial. This wonderfully gentle oil also has exceptional calming and relaxant properties to help alleviate sleep and stress related disorders.

Southern Rosalina is the perfect option for those who want to combine the multiple known benefits of tea tree with the calming and soothing properties of lavender, brought together in the uniquely fresh, crisp scent of this Tasmanian native.

BOTANICAL NAME: *Melaleuca ericifolia*

DESCRIPTION: An aromatic essential oil from the Tasmanian native *Melaleuca ericifolia*. Similar to Tea Tree, Southern Rosalina carries a mild cineole aroma but, due to its linalool content, is matched with a subtle refreshing lavender reminiscence.

AROMA: Pleasant native Australian bush scent with fresh, sweet floral-herbaceous back notes.

EXTRACTION: Steam distilled from the freshly cut leaf and branchlets of the *Melaleuca ericifolia* plant.
