With such a uniquely beautiful and distinctive aroma, true French lavender, *Lavandula angustifolia*, has been used since ancient times for its delicate perfume as well as its medicinal properties.



Tasmania has a long history of cultivating superior quality *Lavandula angustifolia*, using plant selections that were first brought to Tasmania from France in the early 1900s. Over the years, EOT has worked closely with the University of Tasmania to complete a rigorous selection program to produce and establish Tasmanian Lavender, a plant with an exceptionally fine fragrance, which is now recognised as its own distinctive sub-species.
